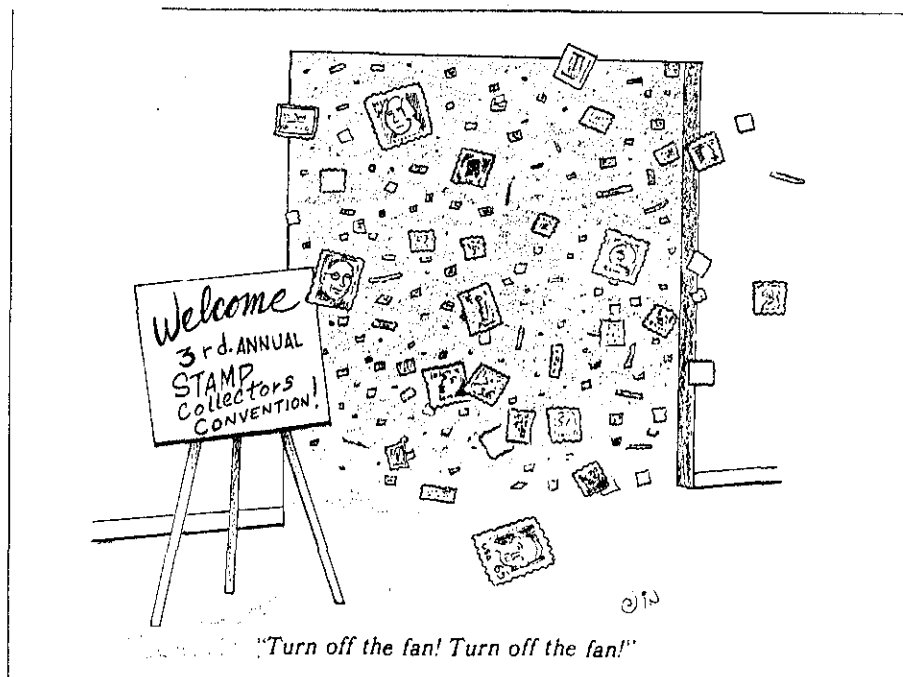

Thank you so much for your interest, support and donation to our Stamp Program. Because of the generosity of people like you, we were able to purchase the van for our homes. It arrived in May of 1982, and the residents have been enjoying it for various trips ever since.

In our Stamp Group, the residents cut and sort the stamps we receive into various categories (high value, commemorative and foreign are the most valuable) but we will still accept common and Christmas stamps. After we've accumulated a few pounds of each, the Stamp Collector, Mr. Lake, purchases them by the pound. The money we receive for the stamps is used exclusively for the van: for gas, maintenance, etc...

When sending stamps, please do not try to take the stamp off the envelope or cut it too close to the edge; leave at least a half to a quarter inch around each stamp.

Again, thank you for everything you've done; your time and effort are really appreciated. May God bless you.
