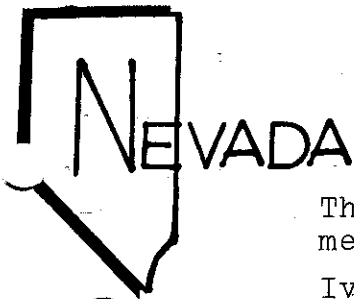

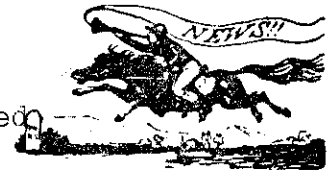

With 30 lots on the board for auction only 10 remained. Jerry was Auctioneer and Richard served as runner.

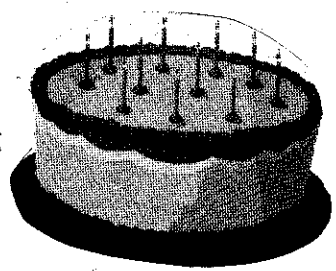
The meeting adjourned at 3:25.

Nevpex '93 in Reno

The Nevada Stamp Study Society will sponsor Nevpex '93 June 19-20 at the Pioneer Theatre Auditorium, 100 S. Virginia St., Reno, Nev. The show will be open free to the public from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. both days.

Nevpex will feature exhibits, a bourse of stamp dealers, a United States Postal Service substation with a special cancellation, a cacheted cover and a youth table. At this table, stamps, first-day covers and other items will be available for 1¢ each.

Club members and dealers will be contributing these items for the youth table. Anything not sold at the show will be donated to the USPS' programs in the Reno area to promote stamp collecting among school-age children. ■
