It seems sets of keys are missing for our meeting room. If anyone has keys please contact Walt Sommer or Al.

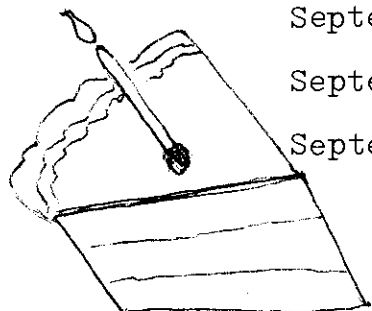
The drawing was held with ten packets of First Day Covers given by Ron Schultz. Some very pretty sets! Hugo Havet won the cash.
