We had a great presentation from Scott Carey representing the Nevada Sesquicentennial Celebration. I worked with Scott for a few years at the City of Sparks - City Works, so it was nice reconnecting on a personal level.

Scott is the Event Manager of this celebration and he did a fantastic job explaining that the Nevada 150 Celebration is a year long celebrating commemorating the 150th Anniversary of Nevada's Statehood which Governor Sandoval put in to action Nevada Day 2013. There are literally hundreds of local community events that are included during this special time. I was going to list some in the news letter but there are just too many wonderful things happening around Nevada that you really need to go to their website and check it out. Quite a few of these events are still looking for volunteers so if you want to get involved in this celebration it is never too late. The artist is going to be at our stamp show later this month and our Greater Reno Stamp Show is one of the sanctioned events for both the Nevada 150 Celebration as well as being part of Artown. The City of Sparks is going to the dogs! Beginning this month, residents of 89431 may have their personal pet dogs spayed or neutered for a discounted fee of just \$20 at the Nevada Humane Society clinic. Thanks to funding by PetSmart Charities® the campaign will run for 12 months and will aim to alter 1,400 dogs within the 89431 zip code.

Pet parents who wish to take advantage of this offer must make an appointment by calling 775-856-2000 ext. 333. The campaign is based on availability, and calls will be returned in the order they are received. The special spay/neuter fee of just \$20 rate is even less than the organization's normal low-cost priced and is available only to residents in the 89431 zip code of Sparks.

Nevada Statehood stamp will show Valley of Fire state park



The design for the Nevada Statehood stamp to be issued May 29, 2014 was unveiled in mid-April by the United States Postal Service.

Nevada artist Ron Spears created the stamp illustration that shows a scene from Valley of Fire State Park near the town of Overton.

"Captured by Spears at dawn, the sandstone formations glow in shades of brilliant reds and yellows — a result of various quantities of iron in the rock — highlighted by deep purple and blue shadows," stated the U.S. Postal Service description of the stamp design. "The colors contrast dramatically with the whiteness of the silica in the foreground."

The official first-day ceremony for the Nevada Statehood commemorative forever stamp will take place at 11 a.m. at the Smith Center for the Performing Arts, 361 Symphony Park Ave., in Las Vegas. The state celebrates its 150th anniversary on Oct. 31, 2014.

The stamp will be issued in a pane of 20.
