## **Auction Bucks Auction Report**By John Walter

**Mike Potter** and **Erik Fields** were the auctioneers for the Auction Bucks auction with **Nadiah Beekun** helping.

There were 62 lots with \$225,165 (auction bucks) spent. The most expensive item was an 1886 silver dollar (99% silver) which sold for \$40,000. A small wall clock went for \$28,000; a larger clock went for AB \$25,000. Philatelic items: UN collection – \$15,000; British Commonwealth collection - \$20,000; mystery box - \$15,000. Wine bottles went for about \$1,000, and large plastic bins went for \$9,000. This was the largest number of auction bucks ever spent at one of these auctions.
